The unit with the most hours each year will be awarded "First Place" and is authorized to award the gold star attachment to cadets for wear on this ribbon. The units with the second and third highest personnel hours per cadet will be awarded second and third place honors and will be authorized to award the silver and bronze star attachments, respectively. In the case of ties, a subcommittee of M-Day staff appointed by the Executive Officer shall determine placement based on criteria listed in 3-2(b). The average monthly strength for the months of September through April will be the strength used to determine eligibility for this award. The time period of 16 April through 15 April of the following year will be the basis for calculating hours for this award.
